

# RECYCLE RACERS

Turn old junk into good times

Recycling is good for us and even better for wildlife! When we throw away less, we reduce the need for ugly landfills and burning, which in turn cuts down on greenhouse gases. Recycling old items can even give them a new lease of life!

Take the Recycle Racers team challenge to make recycling household items serious fun.



## Step 1

Visit the NEA's recycling webpage ([bit.ly/NEA\\_3Rsforhouseholds](http://bit.ly/NEA_3Rsforhouseholds)) to find out what you can recycle at home. Then, collect everyday waste items around the house:



### EXAMPLES

- Plastic "clamshell" boxes for fruit or eggs
- Glass jars
- Junk mail
- Styrofoam containers
- Aluminium drink cans
- Newspaper
- Ketchup bottle
- Cardboard boxes
- Used tissues
- Snack wrappers

## Step 2

Divide the players into teams and present each team with a mix of recyclable and non-recyclable items.



## Step 4

Line everybody up a short distance from the waste-sorting centre. On "Go", a member of each team takes one item and puts it into the correct bin before tagging the next racer. The first team to sort all their items correctly wins!

## Step 3

Set up a waste-sorting centre for each team with separate containers for paper, metal, glass, plastic and non-recyclable waste.
