



Suggested Park Itinerary

- 9.30am** Start your day meeting our babies! Go behind-the-scenes to our bird nursery, the **Breeding & Research Centre** and see how we nurture our adorable hatchlings into fine young birds.
- 10.00am** Fly over next door to **Hawk Arena** and catch the majestic **Kings of the Skies Show**. Witness the magnificent abilities of our dynamic raptors as they demonstrate what they were born to do – hunt.
- 10.30am** Waddle down to **Penguin Coast** and catch our tuxedo cuties in action. Start off at our outdoor enclosure, home of our African penguins, where you get to feed them for \$5. Then head indoors and meet the majestic king penguin and more!
- 11.00am** Flock over to the **Pools Amphitheatre** for the **High Flyers Show** and catch our amazing feathered talents. Witness Amigo, our yellow-naped Amazon parrot, sing in three languages.
- 11.30pm** Feeling famished? Head over to **Hawk Café** and savour our best-selling Hainanese chickenrice prepared with only the freshest ingredients by our chefs. Other must-tries include laksa, nasi lemak and our western fare.
- 12.45pm** Make your way over to the **Wings of Asia** aviary – home to some of the region's most endangered birds like the Bali mynah and Santa-cruz ground dove.
- 1.15pm** Make your way to **Lory Loft** – interact up close with our colourful lorries by offering them their favourite food. They're so friendly that they may even perch on your shoulders!
- 1.45pm** Housing some of the most magnificent hunters, the **Birds of Prey** exhibit houses a variety of raptors. The exhibit is also the only place outside of the Philippines that you can visit the critically endangered Philippine eagle.
- 2.15pm** Simulating a 360-degree walk through a rainforest canopy, **African Treetops** houses some of the most startlingly attractive starlings and turacos. Journey down to the lower tier and you may see ground-dwelling birds forage for food.
- 2.45pm** Explore our 13-storey high **Waterfall Aviary** for an immersive experience into the world of over 600 free flying birds in what is probably one of the world's largest walk-in aviary.
- 3.30pm** Head towards **Parrot Paradise** and visit some of the world's rarest parrots! Move on to the Park Entrance and enjoy the picturesque scenery of one of our most photographed places in the Park – **Flamingo Lake**.
- 4.00pm** Be sure to stop by the retail shops and bring home a memorable souvenir from your visit with us!
